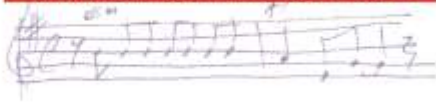

The award ceremony will take place during the Closing Gala on Thursday, February 16th at the Quebec City's Capitole where the network of performing arts professionals will gather to mark of the 25th anniversary of La Bourse RIDEAU.

Created in 1978, the Réseau indépendant des diffuseurs d'événements artistiques unis (RIDEAU) – independent network of united presenters of artistic events – is a national association of show presenters. The membership spans throughout the Quebec territory and also in francophone Canada. Their activities aim to provide the communities they serve an access to excellent and diversified artistic performances. RIDEAU's mission consists in structuring, documenting and promoting the presentation of live arts.

RIDEAU represents 160 members, 250 concert halls, networks found on the entire territory, 10 000 performances and 3,4 million audience members on an yearly basis.
